SUCCESS IN SUMMER PRACTICE

- In the summer practice, students are responsible for doing tasks shown in the instruction in accordance with the rules, and submitting the summer practice report that summarizes the studies to the commission by the last day of the course registration period when following school term after the summer. Additionally, students must enroll in the summer practice course during the registration period.
- Students who are terminated due to absenteeism or do not hand over summer practice reports by the deadline are deemed to have not completed summer practice. If summer practice course registration has been made the student is given a "D" grade.
- The evaluation of the summer practice report of the students who submit the summer practice report on time is graded as "B-Successful" or "K-Unsuccessful" depending on the following three conditions.
 - 1. Adequacy of the Summer Practice Report.
 - 2. "Summer Practice Success Certificate" grades sent as "confidential" by the institution where the summer practice took place.
 - 3. "Inspector Academic Member Report" given by the academic member who inspects the student.
- The commission may give the student the right to correct the summer practice report in form and content.
- If the commission deems it necessary, they can take the student to an oral exam about what they have done during the summer practice or they can make the student practice.
- Students who get a "D" grade or fail the summer practice can change the institution on the condition that get conformity permission from the commission.
