5(i) ENGLISH COURSES PLACEMENT EXAM (for Exemption from 5(i) English courses)

(Tuesday, September 10, 2024)

Dear Students,

Students in Gazi University's undergraduate and associate degree programs in Turkish language of instruction are required to take the English Proficiency Exam *in order to be exempt from the 5(i) compulsory English courses* given in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades.

Students who are going to take/need to retake English courses in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades of the relevant departments can take the English Proficiency Exam. Students will be exempted from the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year English courses according to the score ranges they get from the exam. Students who do not attend the exam and students who do not succeed in the exam are required to take English courses in the relevant classes.

4th grade English lessons cannot be exempted.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE ENGLISH PLACEMENT/ PROFICIENCY EXAM

1. The exam will start at 10.00 am on Tuesday, September 10th and will last 110 minutes and finish at 11.50 am. All of the students will take the exam **in their own faculties/vocational colleges.**

2. Faculties and vocational colleges of which students who will take the 5(i) English Proficiency Exam are as follows:

- Faculty of Science

- Faculty of Nursing
- Faculty of Health Sciences
- Faculty of Sport Sciences

- OSTİM Vocational College of Technical Sciences
- Vocational College of Health Services

3. All candidates are required to present a **pictured identity document** (identity card, passport, driver's license, etc.) **and also student ID or student certificate that they received during registration (it can also be taken from E-Devlet)** when they come for the exam. Students also should have stationery supplies such as pencil, eraser, sharpener, etc. with them.





4. The exam consists of various types of 80 multiple-choice questions that cover reading comprehension and language use. The exam takes 110 minutes. You are not allowed to leave the exam room in the first 30 minutes and the last 15 minutes of the exam.
5. Students will be exempted from their English courses in their departments based on the following grade ranges they will receive in the exam.

NOTE 1: Students can take this exam in order to *pass English courses they have failed or to be exempted from the courses they need to take in subsequent academic years, and they will have the opportunity to be *exempted from the relevant courses based on the relevant grade ranges.

*excluding 4th grade courses

NOTE 2: Based on the English Proficiency exam results, the letter grade for the courses from which students are exempted will be recorded as “AA”.

6. Which international English language proficiency exam scores are accepted for exemption from the relevant courses? What scores do I need to get from these exams in order to be exempt from the relevant courses?

7. How should I prepare for the exam? What should I do before the exam?

5(i) English Language Proficiency Exam is a general language proficiency test at A1-A2 and B1+ language proficiency levels. The exam measures intermediate and advanced cognitive language skills such as:

- contextual vocabulary and grammar,
- reading comprehension,
- sentence completion,
- finding the missing sentence in the paragraph,
- finding the sentence that distorts the meaning in the paragraph,
- deriving meaning from signs and warnings
- sentential paraphrase
- dialog completion

To prepare for the exam, you can revise your previous English courses at the lower level, use free online resources or printed materials to work on English vocabulary, grammar, and reading comprehension.

Because the exam is based on multiple-choice questions, you can practice similar types of questions. Additionally, you can improve your question-solving skills by utilizing resources that provide information about multiple-choice question-solving methods and techniques.

Since the exam is time-restricted, it is important to manage your time well. You can improve your time management skills by solving similar types and numbers of questions before the exam.

Finally, it may be a good idea to engage in a relaxing activity (such as listening to music, taking a walk, or reading a book) before the exam to manage your exam stress and anxiety well.
